Instructions for Boys:

1. There should not be coloured prints/borders/embroideries etc. on the dress. **Instructions**

for Girls:

1. There should not be coloured prints/borders/embroideries etc. on the dress.
2. Students should avoid Anarkali/front slit/fancier styles for kurta and salwar/patiala styles for the bottom.
3. If you are going with saree option, the border of the saree must be golden in colour.
4. Blouse must be white and simple in style. The blouse may/may not have a golden border. There should not be coloured prints/embroideries etc. on the saree or blouse.

Footwear: Wear formal chappals (eg. Kolhapuri). Avoid any fancy style chappals/shoes.

Degree recipients are required to make their own arrangements for the Convocation dress. Degree recipients failing to adhere to the dress code specified here may not be permitted entry into the Convocation Hall.
