Respected Sir/Madam,

With the objective of ensuring the development of students, youth, and young women belonging to the Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) of the Open Category in Maharashtra, the Government of Maharashtra, vide reference no. 1, has approved the establishment of the Academy of Maharashtra Research, Upliftment and Training (AMRUT). A subsequent corrigendum under reference no. 2 has also been issued in this regard.

As per these references, the AMRUT institution has been established as a new autonomous body with the objective of implementing various initiatives and programs aimed at the welfare and development of the Open Category candidates who do not receive benefits from any other government departments, corporations, or agencies.

According to the said corrigendum, the beneficiary group of the AMRUT institution has been clearly defined. Based on details available in the public domain, the following communities in Maharashtra generally fall under this Open Category beneficiary group: Brahmin, Kayastha, Komati, Marwadi, Patel, Rajput, Yelmar, Ayyangar, Rajpurohit, Patidar, Vaishya, Nair, Naidu, Kamma, Sindhi, Baniya, Bengali, Tyagi, Senkunthar, Gujarati, Thakur, Jat, etc. As this information is sourced from public platforms, it is subject to change as per future government policies regarding inclusion or exclusion of any communities, sub-castes, or sub-groups. Kindly take note of this.

AMRUT is implementing a financial assistance scheme specifically for students from its targeted beneficiary groups who have secured admission in AIIMS, IIM, IIT, and IIIT institutes. The details of the scheme are as follows:

- The scheme aims to provide financial support to students belonging to the Economically Weaker Sections of the Open Category — as defined by AMRUT — who have secured admission to full-time degree/postgraduate degree/postgraduate diploma programs in prestigious institutions such as AIIMS, IIM, IIT, and IIIT, which are recognized by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. This financial assistance is intended to help students complete their education without facing financial obstacles.
- Under this scheme, students admitted to full-time degree/postgraduate degree/postgraduate diploma programs in AIIMS, IIM, IIT, and IIIT will be provided financial assistance of ₹10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) per month until the

completion of their course. The assistance will be disbursed in two installments within each academic year.

- The applicable duration for financial assistance will be based on the course duration specified by the respective institution. For the purpose of calculating annual assistance, each academic year will be considered as a period of 11 months.

- AMRUT also operates several other schemes. Detailed information about all such schemes is available on the AMRUT website. Eligible candidates are encouraged to explore and avail the benefits of these schemes as well.

AMRUT (Academy of Maharashtra, Research, Upliftment and Training) is implementing a Financial Assistance Scheme for students who have secured admission to AIIMS, IIM, IIT, and IIIT institutes.

The details of the scheme are as follows:

- The scheme aims to provide financial assistance to students belonging to Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) of the Open Category from AMRUT's defined beneficiary communities, including: Brahmin, Kayastha, Komati, Marwari, Patel, Rajput, Yelmar, Iyengar, Rajpurohit, Patidar, Vaishya, Nair, Naidu, Kamma, Sindhi, Baniya, Bengali, Tyagi, Senkunthar, Gujarati, Thakur, Jat, etc.
- These students must have secured admission to full-time degree / postgraduate degree / postgraduate diploma programs at prestigious institutions recognized by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India — namely AIIMS, IIM, IIT, and IIIT. The objective of this scheme is to ensure that such students do not face financial obstacles in completing their education.
- Under this scheme, students admitted to the above-mentioned full-time courses will be provided financial assistance of ₹10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) per month until the completion of their course. The assistance will be disbursed twice in an academic year.
- The duration of the financial assistance will correspond to the official course duration specified by the respective institution. For each academic year, 11 months will be considered for calculating the benefit period once the student applies under the scheme.
- Applications for beneficiary selection will be invited online through AMRUT's official website: <https://mahaamrut.org.in/>
- AMRUT also operates several other schemes. Detailed information about all such schemes is available on the AMRUT website. Eligible candidates are encouraged to explore and avail the benefits of these schemes as well.
